This week we are learning how God can give us spiritual armour for our protection.

Dear Parents/Carers,

This week is definitely going to be a busy one with Y5 off to the Waterside Centre, Y3/4 visiting St Crispin's to meet RAP artist and poet, Karl Nova, Y5/6 competing in a Cricket Competition, District Sports Athletics and of course our own School Sports Day.

As this is the first Sports day with Parents for 3 years, it has taken some careful organisation to ensure it runs smoothly. On Wednesday 29th June, all children should come to school in their PE kit and with securely fitted trainers. It would be helpful for your child to have a named water bottle, sun hat and please apply sunblock before they come to school in the morning.

Reception / KS1 10.30 - 12.00pm

Parents should line up outside the main reception from 10.15am onwards and sign in. The doors will be open at 10.25pm so that parents can make their way to the field. At 10.30am, the children will walk onto the field in their teams and line up for their first activity. At this time, parents will be able to find their child/children. Teachers will start the activity. When all groups have finished, a siren will sound and everyone will walk to their next activity. Once all 6 activities have been completed, everyone will walk to the running track for some races. Parents will be able to follow their children around the course and will be shown where to sit for the races. At the end of the event, children will be taken back into school. Parents will be asked to sign out and leave by the gate next to reception.

KS2 1.00-3.00pm

Parents should line up outside the main reception from 12.45pm onwards and sign in. The doors will be open at 12.50pm so that parents can make their way to the field. At 1.00pm, the children will walk onto the field in their teams and line up for their first activity. At this time, parents will be able to find their child/children. Teachers will start the activity. When all groups have finished, a siren will sound and everyone will walk to their next activity. KS2 children will complete 10 activities. Parents will be able to follow their children around the course. At the end of the event, children will be taken onto the top playground, where the results will be announced and Sports Day Cup presented. At the end of the KS2 event, all children will return to their classrooms to be dismissed in the normal way.

Please note, children are expected to stay with their teacher and groups at all times. They will not require extra snacks. Siblings must be closely supervised and the adventure playground is strictly out of bounds for everyone. School lunches will be available as normal on this day.

<u>Lunch Boxes</u>—Over the past few months we have noticed that lunch boxes are containing treats that are not appropriate for a healthy lunch. A lunch box should contain food such as sandwiches, pasta, fruit, vegetables and yogurt. Chocolate biscuits and Sweets are not permitted. Please check the website for more advice on making a healthy lunch box. In addition, children are allowed a piece of fruit or vegetable as a snack. Thank you for your support in this.

Finally, we have a huge collection of lost property in school at the moment. In many cases, the name has been washed out/ is illegible. All lost property will be put out on the playground next to where the PTA are selling ice-creams this Friday. Please come and take a look.
