Dear Parents/Carers,

This half term has whizzed by and it was lovely to finish with our Jubilee picnic. Fortunately, the weather stayed dry and the whole school enjoyed eating their lunch on the field. We were visited by her majesty, Queen Elizabeth II (a life size cardboard version) and lots of children practised their curtsey or bow. During the afternoon, the children took part in sporting challenges and games including an obstacle course, relay races and throwing the javelin.

Another highlight of this week has been the Y3/4 trip to Harry Potter World. This was a real 'awe and wonder' trip for the children as they experienced the vastness of the set and the special effects. Of course, their behaviour was superb as usual and I know our children will be welcomed back in the future.

After ½ term, children will begin their swimming lessons and I have attached the timetable to this newsletter. Children have already been grouped according to ability with the information we have, but these groups will be reassessed and pupils swapped if necessary. Please send your child with their swimming bag for the first day they appear on the timetable.

Children must have the correct swim wear (one-piece costume, swimming trunks or closely fitted above the knee swim shorts) for swimming lessons. Swimming hats are compulsory. These can be purchased through school via Tucasi and will be delivered to classes on the first day back after ½ term. Please note, the office will not accept cash for swimming hats. If your child wears goggles for swimming, please make sure they are properly fitted. Staff will not be able to adjust them at school. Also, I would like to remind you to make sure everything is named – hat, towel, goggles, uniform. From past experience, I know we end up with a huge amount of lost property in the summer term.

As the weather warms up, please remember to send your child with a sun hat and apply sun block before they come to school. Of course, it is always worth putting a raincoat in the bag just in case!

During the hot weather, it is really helpful if children bring a named water bottle into school. This should be taken home each day, washed and brought back into school the next day. Water bottles must be filled with water – not juice!

Finally, I would just like to wish everyone a happy half term and we will see the children back in school on Monday 6th June.
