This week we are thinking about Patience.

Dear Parents/Carers,

Welcome back! I hope you have had a restful 1/2 term.

Following the updated government guidance on 'Living with Covid 19', we are able to make changes to our mitigation measures. Consequently, it is no longer a requirement to wear a face covering on our school site.

However, we have chosen to continue using a one-way system on our school site in the morning. This allows us to keep our site secure during this period so that children are safe to walk around to class by themselves. Please continue to follow the one-way system to avoid bottle necks.

In school, our primary Covid mitigation measures will continue to be good ventilation, good hand hygiene, regular cleaning and 'Catch it, Kill it, Bin it' to manage sneezes.

Or course, Covid has not gone away. The advice for children is still to stay at home if they have symptoms, and order a PCR test, remaining at home while waiting for the test result. If anyone does test positive, we will ask them to isolate for a minimum of five full days after the day of a positive test before then going back to school if they have tested negative twice. This is now advice not a legal requirement, we will follow the advice.

As we are moving towards normality, we will be able to re-establish some of our larger group/whole school gatherings. The Academisation Parent Consultation meeting will now take place in the Acorns Hall. Doors will be open from 6.15pm.

However, Stories for Breakfast to celebrate World Book Day on Thursday 3rd March will only involve the children again this year. The logistics make it too difficult to rearrange at short notice. Don't forget to send your child dressed as a book character on this day.

Sadly, Ms Dunn, who has been working closely with our families for many years will be leaving to start a new job in two weeks. Ms Drinkwater will take over the Breakfast Club and we are in the process of recruiting a new member of staff to take on Ms Dunn's other responsibilities.
