Dear Parents,

This week, it is our Harvest Festival which will be held in school over Teams this year. As we have decided to hold our annual food line competition on Wednesday, you still have time to send in donations to increase the length of your child's food line. The prize for the longest line is a class Mufti day. All items collected will be delivered to the Wokingham Food Bank at the end of the week.

The number of Covid cases in Wokingham schools is high at the moment, although we have been fortunate to not have any cases in All Saints. Wokingham Borough Council have provided additional guidance for all Wokingham schools.

Siblings of Positive Pupils: As you will be aware, sibling transmission is a key factor in onward infection control. If a sibling in the household has a positive test we would now request that you arrange for any unaffected siblings to take a PCR test on day 3 or 5 and keep them at home until you get a negative PCR result. In this way, we can help to prevent onward transmission.

All schools have been given authority by that letter to use code x for that absence unless the sibling is unwell and actually has symptoms.

When booking a PCR test online, or ordering home testing kits, please be assured that you are able to do so if you are asymptomatic and identified as a close contact. To do this, please select the below options which will enable them to continue with the booking:
