Year 6: Kayzen K—Showing compassion and curiosity in his Geography learning this week and last! He has asked insightful questions and sought to understand a lot about climate change!


Year 6: Dylan S— Showing curiosity in English. You have listened and worked hard to produce a wonderful narrative
