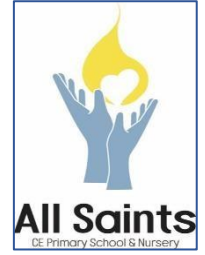


# All Saints CE Primary School and Nursery Newsletter Summer 2 July 5th 2024
