KEEP SAFE IN WOKINGHAM CAMPAIGN FEBRUARY 2025

'Involve Community Services' and Wokingham's Community Safety Partnership are hosting Wokingham Borough's first KEEP SAFE CAMPAIGN.

This campaign is dedicated to promoting safety for all our residents. A launch webinar on 3 February will introduce a series of **virtual learning sessions** throughout February for people of all ages focusing on online safety and understanding how this can impact on keeping safe in the physical world.


The campaign will bring together voluntary sector groups, local government professionals, schools and other key partners to collaborate and share resources to keep our community safe.

With learning events targeted at different audiences including parents and carers, people of all ages and local practitioners, we hope to bring a greater awareness to challenges such as cybercrime, e.g. scams and hacking and how to avoid being a victim, technology enabled abuse and how everyone can keep safe on-line. The aim is to help residents to navigate the digital world safely.
