Dear Families,

During my time at All Saints, I have always aimed to make changes that would benefit both the school and the community. As part of my strategic role, the strengthening of parental engagement is a key objective. To support this, some of the initiatives I am most proud of include:

- Enhancing our **outdoor learning space**, particularly the garden classroom—many thanks to the church group for their incredible support in this area.
- A huge thank you to the **ongoing support of the church**, not only for helping with weekly worship but for allowing us to use the church for all our celebrations—it has been invaluable
- We have also worked on **revitalising the governing body**, led by our capable and committed Chair of Governors, to ensure strong leadership and strategic direction for the school's continued growth.

Leaving this school and its amazing community is incredibly difficult for me. I have absolutely loved my time here and I will always treasure the relationships I have built with staff, families, and most importantly, the children.

However, I take comfort in knowing that All Saints is in very capable hands. Miss. Hunter will be leading the school forward and I have no doubt that she will continue to nurture and grow all that makes this school special.

Thank you for all the kindness, support, and encouragement you have shown me over the years. I will truly miss being part of this community, but I know that All Saints will continue to thrive.

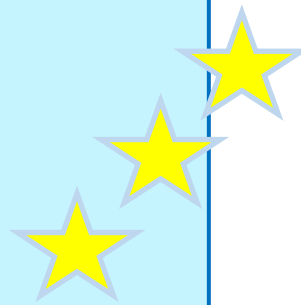
