We are delighted to share some positive news about this year's school swimming arrangements, and we're especially pleased to confirm that all children from Reception through to Year 6 will be taking part in swimming lessons this summer.

Following careful planning, and in support of both efficient use of resources across our schools and our continued commitment to collaborative working within the trust, we have reviewed how best to deliver swimming this year. With two pools located within a short walk of each other, it has been agreed that we will once again operate one shared pool for the summer term.

We are pleased to confirm that, as the most ready-to-run facility, Keeppatch pool will be used again this year. This enables us to ensure a smooth, high-quality experience for all pupils, while making the very best use of our shared facilities.

We know how important swimming is for children's confidence, safety, and enjoyment, and we are really excited that every year group (with the exception of nursery) will have the opportunity to participate. Our aim is to begin lessons as soon as possible after the May Bank Holiday, and we will share confirmed dates and time all our childslots with you in the coming weeks.

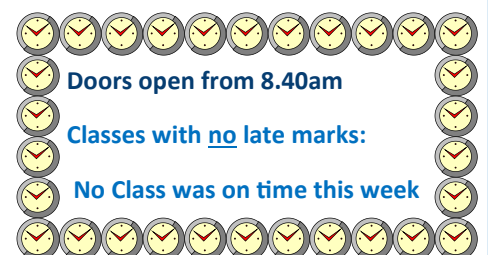

# Should I keep my child off school?

## Yes

### Until...

Chickenpox	at least 5 days from the onset of the rash and until all blisters have crusted over
Diarrhoea and Vomiting	48 hours after their last episode
Cold and Flu-like illness (including COVID-19)	they no longer have a high temperature and feel well enough to attend. Follow the national guidance if they've tested positive for COVID-19.
Impetigo	their sores have crusted and healed, or 48 hours after they started antibiotics
Measles	4 days after the rash first appeared
Mumps	5 days after the swelling started
Scabies	they've had their first treatment
Scarlet Fever	24 hours after they started taking antibiotics
Whooping Cough	48 hours after they started taking antibiotics

Head lice	Tonsillitis
Threadworms	Slapped cheek

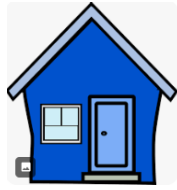

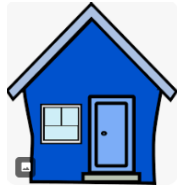
