Dear Parents and Guardians,

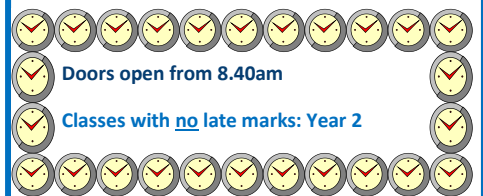

Should I keep my child off school?

Yes

Until...

Chickenpox	at least 5 days from the onset of the rash and until all blisters have crusted over
Diarrhoea and Vomiting	48 hours after their last episode
Cold and Flu-like illness (including COVID-19)	they no longer have a high temperature and feel well enough to attend. Follow the national guidance if they've tested positive for COVID-19.
Impetigo	their sores have crusted and healed, or 48 hours after they started antibiotics
Measles	4 days after the rash first appeared
Mumps	5 days after the swelling started
Scabies	they've had their first treatment
Scarlet Fever	24 hours after they started taking antibiotics
Whooping Cough	48 hours after they started taking antibiotics

Head lice	Tonsillitis
Threadworms	Slapped cheek

- Order a cold packed lunch through Pantry via ParentPay;
- Bring a packed lunch from home; or
- Enjoy a family picnic brought from home.

Parents are very welcome to attend Sports Morning, the Family Picnic, or both events.

For the safety and safeguarding of all pupils, please be aware that the school side gates will remain closed while Sports Morning is taking place, and parents will not be able to come and go from the site outside of the designated times below.

If you are attending Sports Morning only:

- Entry: 9.15am–9.30am
- Exit: 11.45am–12.00pm

If you are attending the Family Picnic only:

- Entry: 11.45am–12.00pm
- Exit: 1.00pm–1.15pm

Please note that, outside of these times, the school gates will be locked and access to the site will not be possible. This is essential to ensure the safety and security of all children throughout the event.

We are thrilled to be able to share this special day with our families and hope it will be a wonderful opportunity to celebrate together as a school community.
