Writing: name, initial sounds and using Fred fingers to segment words for spelling

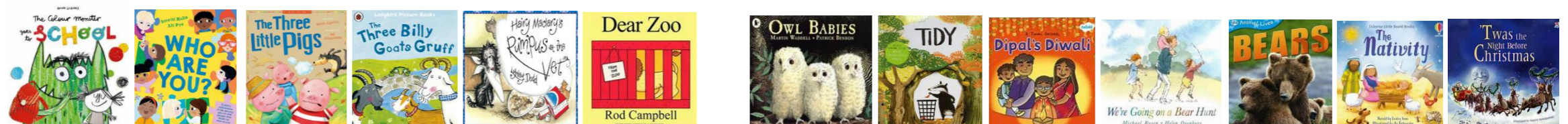
