# Topic work Friday

- Frogs can breath through their nose and skin.
- They catch their food with their long tongue.
- Frogs can see forwards, sideways and upwards all at the same time.
- They never close their eyes even when they are asleep.
- A group of frogs can be called an army.
- Frogs don't drink water they soak it into their body through their skin.
- Frogs shed their skin once a week.
- Some frogs can jump 20 times their body length.
