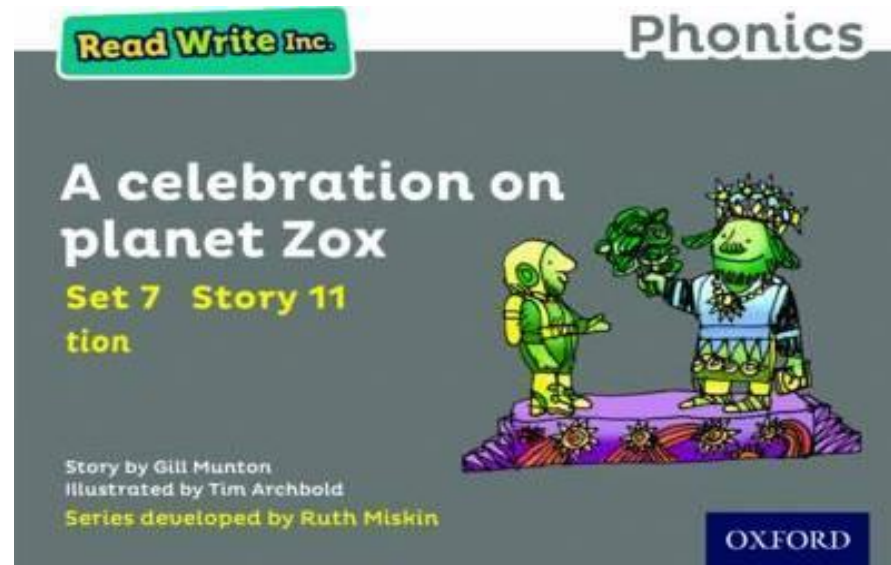

Consonants Ask children to say the sounds.

Story Green Words



Ask children to read the words first in Fred Talk and then say the word.



Ask children to say the syllables and then read the whole word.
