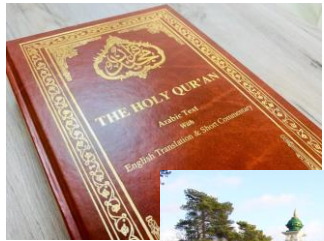
Friendship: a relationship between friends.

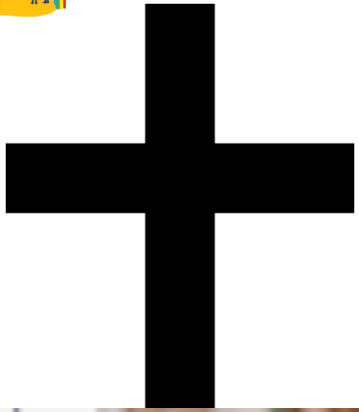
Key Vocabulary

Heal: to make whole or healthy again.

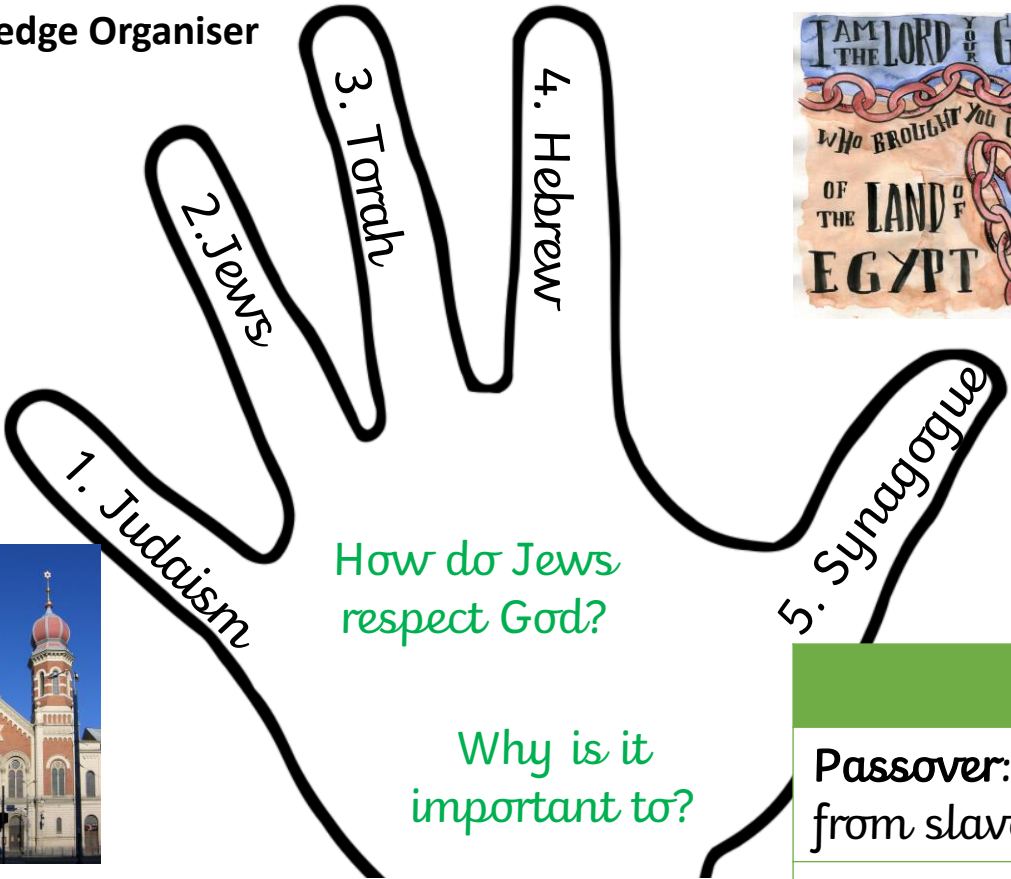
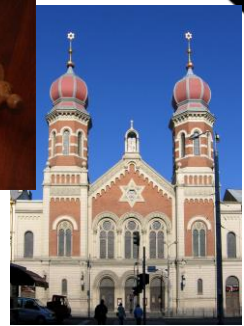
Confidence: feeling sure of ones abilities.

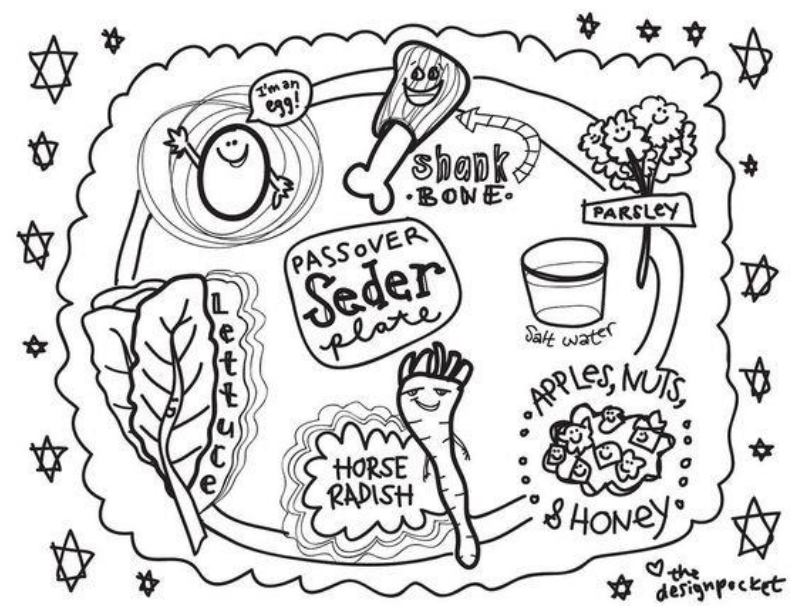
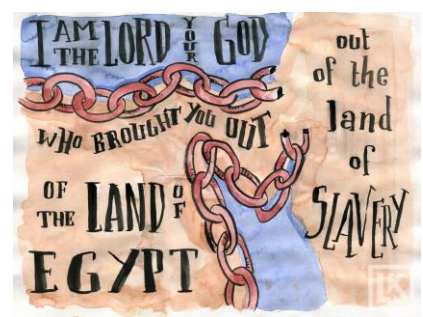

Key Vocabulary

- Passover:** a celebration of the story of Exodus (freedom from slavery in Egypt).
 - Kashrut:** Judaism's food laws.
 - Kosher:** food that is allowed.
 - Trefah:** food that is not allowed.
 - Seder Meal:** a Jewish ritual meal on 1st and 2nd day.
 - Seder plate:** special plate of food eaten at the Seder meal.
 - Ritual:** a series of acts always performed the same way.

Guru Nanak: the founder of Sikhism and first Guru out of 10.

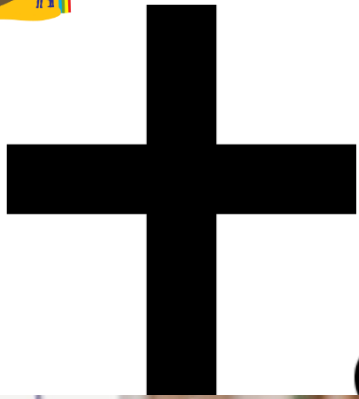
Guru: a spiritual teacher (human) to spread God's message.

Nirgun: the belief God is above and beyond everything.
