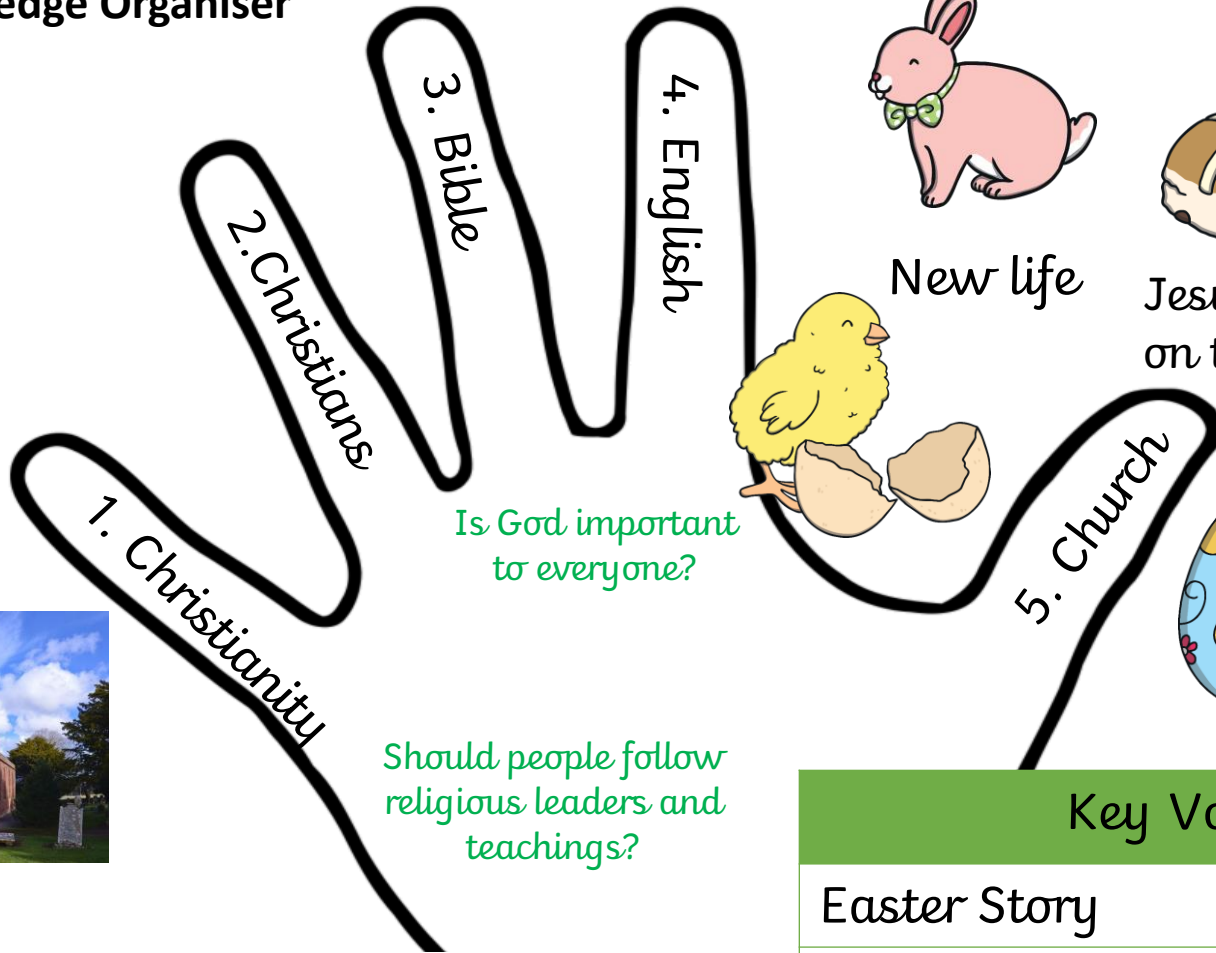
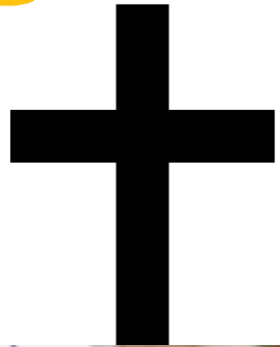
Jerusalem: Where Jesus arrived on Psalm Sunday.

Romans, Gift, Palm Leaves, Jesus/ Son of God, Messiah

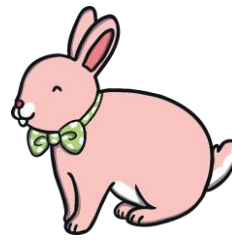
# Why did the crowds on Palm Sunday welcome Jesus like a king?

We are learning to know that Jesus is special to Christians and how his welcome on Palm Sunday shows this.

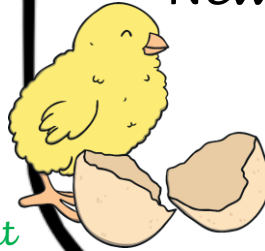

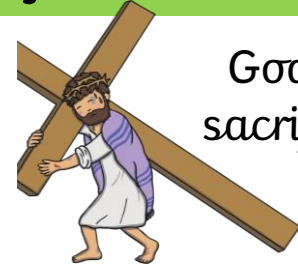

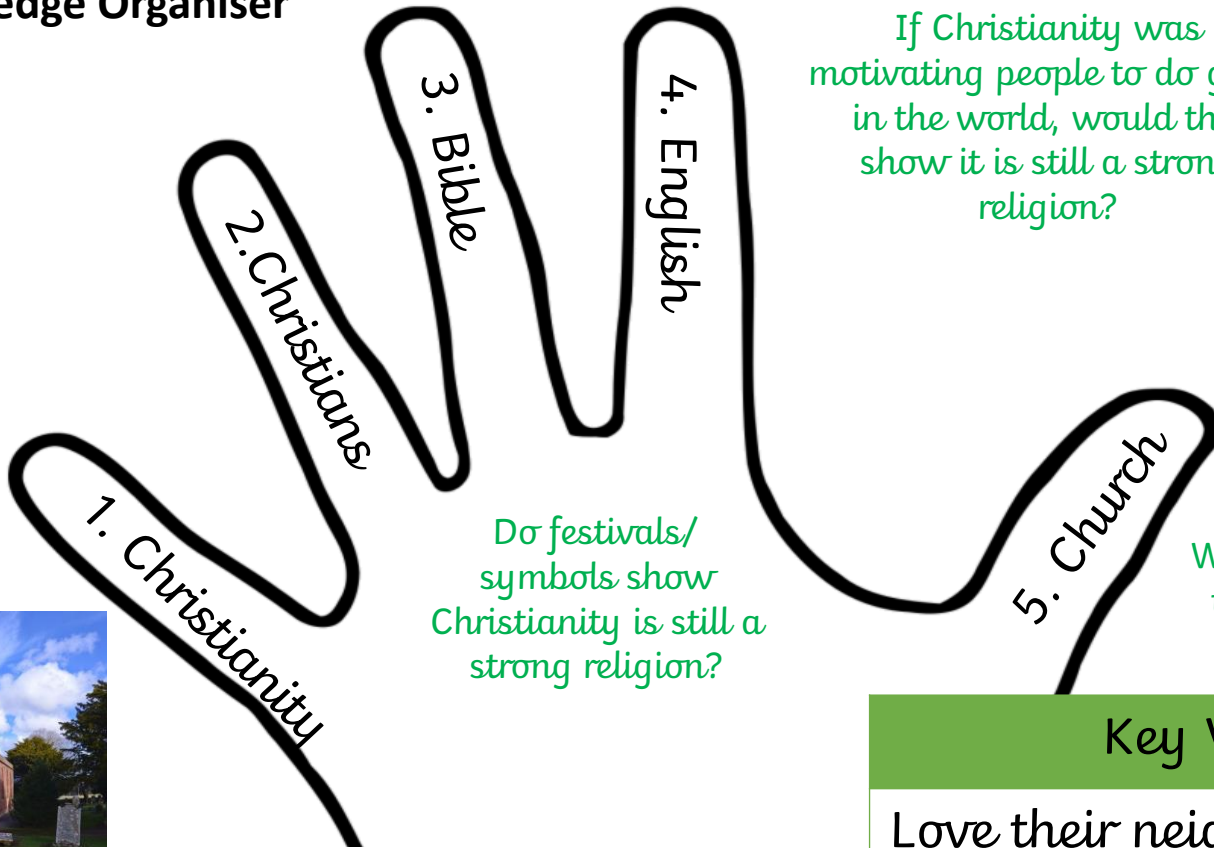
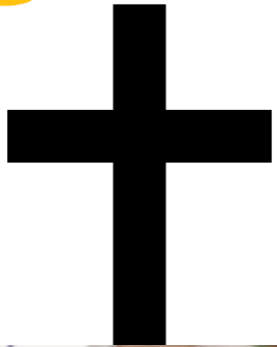


**Key Vocabulary & Bible Stories**
