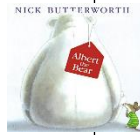

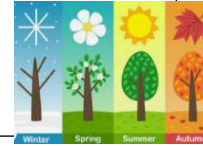

- Change of state – ice-water

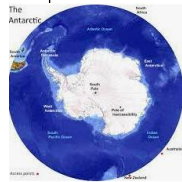
## History
