

Help at home for Level 17

In order to pass Level 17 you need to be able to be able to add any multiple of ten to any two digit number.

A multiple of ten is the 10 times table (e.g 20, 30, 40, 50, 60, 70, 80, 90) .

E.G.

$$56 + 40 = 96$$

$$45 + 30 = 75$$

$$37 + 20 = 57$$

You may find that your answer is a three digit number (includes the hundred column).

$$82 + 30 = 112$$

$$64 + 70 = 134$$

Counting in tens from the two digit number will help you calculate the answer.

Remember:

When adding multiples of tens the units stay the same.
