Money

- Recognise symbols for pounds and pence
- Combine amounts of money
- Find combinations of coins that make the same money
- Simple – and + problems.
- Problem solving – spending money in London and giving change.



Geography

- Know the four countries and capital cities of the UK
- Explore different areas and landmarks in London, through the use of map skills and research.
- Locate our school in relation to London and the rest of the United Kingdom
- Use geographical vocabulary, such as, river, weather, city, factory, house, shop, etc
- Study aerial photographs and maps of London (including Tube Map)
- Find famous places on a map of London
- Find places on a London tube map
- Use the 4 compass points. Use positional language
- Use landmarks to plan a short journey.
- Use Google Maps or Google Earth to go on a virtual walk around the streets of London.
- Look at transport in London
- Look at the Union Jack flag. What does it represent?

- Describe what animals and humans need to survive in an urban habitat (London).

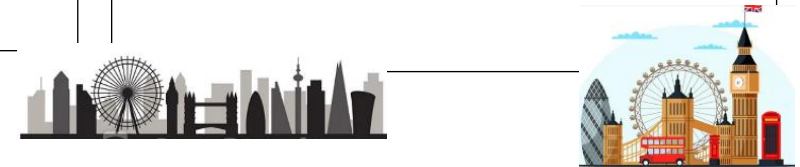
Art
