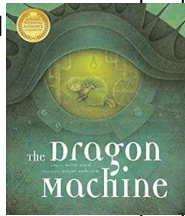

- Drama and oral performances

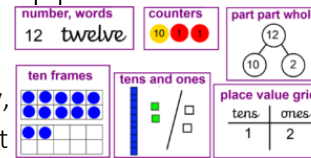


History

Maths

- Read and write numbers to at least 100 in numerals and words and recognise the place value of each digit in a two digit number.
- Identify, represent and estimate numbers using different representations.
- Count in steps of 2, 3 and 5 from any number, forwards and backwards.
- Recall and use addition and subtraction facts to 20 fluently, and derive and use related facts up to 100.
- Add and subtract numbers using concrete objects, pictorial representations, and mentally, including; two-digit number and ones, two-digit number and tens, two two-digit numbers and adding three one -digit numbers.



Science – Everyday materials

- Compare the uses of different everyday materials such as paper, wood, plastic and metal.
- Identify and compare the suitability of a variety of everyday materials.
- Find out how the shapes of solid objects made from some materials can be changed by squashing, bending, twisting and stretching.
- Experimenting which material would make the best rainhat for the queen.

- Understanding how the royal family show and promote Christian values.



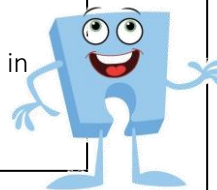
DT – Sewing

- To draw a royal palace or castle using the line skills practised for the picture to be accurate and detailed.

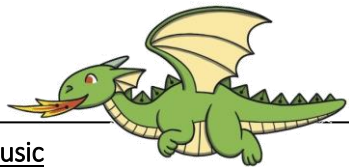
Computing
