

Help at home for Level 18

In order to pass Level 18 you need to be able to be able to take away any multiply of ten from any two digit number.

A multiply of ten is the 10 times table (e.g 20, 30, 40, 50, 60, 70, 80, 90) .

E.G.

$$56 - 40 = 16$$

$$65 - 30 = 35$$

$$77 - 20 = 57$$

$$82 - 50 = 32$$

Counting backwards in tens from the two digit number will help you calculate the answer.

e.g. $56 - 40$, start at 56, then count back in tens 4 times.

56, 46, 36, 26, 16.

Remember:

When subtracting multiples of tens the units stay the same.
