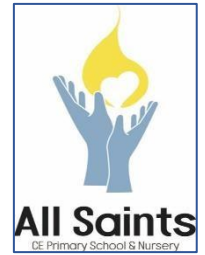

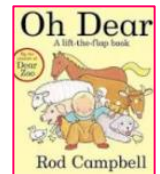

Reception and Nursery were amazing in their performance of 'Oh' Dear by Rod Campbell!

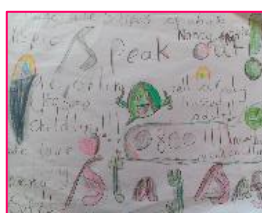
