# EXPANDING EARLY YEARS PROVISION - ALL SAINTS CE PRIMARY SCHOOL

# Purpose of the Nursery Expansion

Frays Academy Trust is committed to creating inspiring and inclusive environments that enable every child to flourish. The proposed nursery will:

- Provide children with the opportunity to begin their educational journey earlier, ensuring access to high-quality teaching and learning experiences that lay a strong foundation for success in primary education and beyond.
- Respond to local demand for early years provision that prioritises excellence in education while supporting children's social, emotional, and cognitive development.



- Strengthen the continuity of learning, enabling children to benefit from a well-planned curriculum and seamless transition into reception and beyond.

# Details of the Proposed Nursery



## Age Group and Provision

If this proposal is successful, the new nursery will cater to children aged 2 years at All Saints CE Primary School.

They will offer a nurturing environment where children can develop their skills through the well-planned Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS) curriculum.

## Location and Space

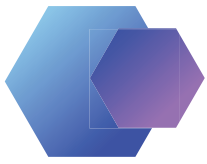
If this proposal is successful, the nursery will make use of surplus school space, reimagined to create child-centred learning areas.

## Timeline

Construction Start Date: Approx. Summer 2026 – depending on approvals

Planned Opening Date: September 2027

Timings will depend on the planning and approval process, so the above is only an approximation.



## Why Starting School a Year Earlier Benefits Children

As an organisation committed to raising aspirations and resilience, we believe in the transformational power of early education:

- **Building Secure Foundations:** Children develop essential early literacy, numeracy, and social skills, equipping them to thrive in reception and beyond.
- **Seamless Transitions:** Children who are familiar with their school environment, peers, and staff transition into reception with confidence and ease.
- **Long-Term Impact:** High-quality early education has been shown to narrow attainment gaps, particularly for disadvantaged children, preparing them for future success.
- **Support for Working Families:** we understand the importance of balancing family life with high-quality early education. Our proposed nursery will provide a nurturing and enriching environment where young children can begin their learning journey. By offering places for nursery age children within the school, families will benefit from the continuity of having siblings in the same setting and a seamless transition into reception. While our primary focus is on delivering exceptional early education, we will work closely with families to understand their needs and provide as much flexibility as possible within our educational framework.

The Trust is deeply rooted in its belief that **partnerships transform outcomes.**

By providing nursery provision within our schools, we:

- Strengthen bonds between families and schools.
