A Truly Magical Week at All Saints

This week has been wonderful as we welcomed two very special visitors, Flash and Jet, our magnificent reindeer guests! From the moment they arrived, the excitement could be felt all around the school, and the children were absolutely enchanted.

Every class enjoyed a dedicated session with Flash and Jet and their knowledgeable keepers. The children had the chance to get up close, learn lots, and even *feed* the reindeer—an experience many described as “the best school day ever!” Staff were just as captivated, learning right alongside the pupils.

Throughout the sessions, we discovered a range of fascinating facts about these remarkable animals. Did you know that reindeer eyes actually change colour with the seasons? In summer they're a warm golden shade, and in winter they transform into a deep Arctic blue to help them see in low light. Male reindeers shed their antlers after the winter rut, and as these are the fastest-growing organs in the animal kingdom, they grow an entirely new set of full-sized antlers in just 12 weeks. Amazingly their new antlers grow back in exactly the same shape every year!

Alongside all this excitement, our assemblies this week have focused on the theme of kindness. We have been thinking about how the kind words we say can brighten someone else's day and how choosing kindness makes *us* feel happier and more connected too. The children shared lots of thoughtful ideas about the power of kindness and ways we can show it every day.

It has truly been a magical week filled with awe, learning, and unforgettable moments. A huge thank you to the handlers, and of course to Flash and Jet for bringing such wonder to our school community. Finally, a huge thank you to the PTA who part funded the visit, which made this experience possible.
