During **Book Week**, some of you were very brave and chose to share a book with your child's class. We are all very appreciative and as the children really enjoyed it, we look forward to repeating this at some time in the summer term.

Another big thankyou to those of you who have sent photographs of your children reading in unusual places. They will be on display .. somewhere soon ... look out!

This term in school is important in the lead up to **Easter**. The children have been learning about the importance of **Lent to Christians** and **Ramadan to Muslims**. They have explored the story of Jesus in the wilderness and the significance of Ash Wednesday. They have listened to the importance of Ramadan and they have explored similarities between the two beliefs.

At home you could:

- Ask your child to talk to you about how Jesus was tempted in the desert.
- Ask your child to explain the meaning of Lent and Ash Wednesday.
- Watch cartoon stories of both events and discuss the links between them.
- Discuss why both religions during this time are asked to say sorry, ask for forgiveness, to pray and to reflect
- Ask your child if they choose to 'give anything up' what would it be and why.
